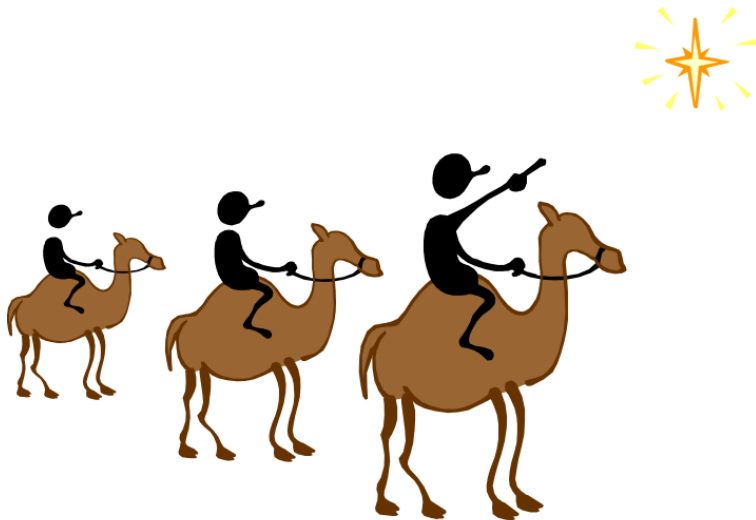


St Helier Methodist Centre January 8th 2023

4) Food bank, we had the highest number of people visiting the food bank in December, we gave out 30 bags of food and £320 of vouchers to 19 people, this included a couple of families who we are currently supporting through a local primary school. The total numbers for 2022 were, 181 bags of food and £2,300 vouchers given to 131 people.
