
St Helier Methodist Centre September 10th, 2023

Today begins an exploration of how the four Gospel writers chose to begin their record of Jesus in very different ways. This Sunday, we'll explore the significance of Matthew genealogies (v1-17), then next week at St Martin's Methodist, Tony will continue with Mark's opening verses. On October 8th, we'll continue with Luke, and the following week conclude with John's Gospel.
