
# St Helier Methodist Centre January 14th, 2024

This week we will remember in prayer St Helier Anglican Church – The Town Church, Very Rev Mike Keirle, Rev James Porter.

Aurelius Clemens Prudentius was a Roman Christian, born in Northern Spain in 348. He came of a distinguished Roman family, studied law, and was twice governor of a province. Towards the end of his life (possibly around 392) Prudentius retired from public life to become an ascetic, fasting until evening and devoted himself to poetry in the service of Christ. Today we sing one of his hymns, 'Bethlehem, of Noblest Cities'.
