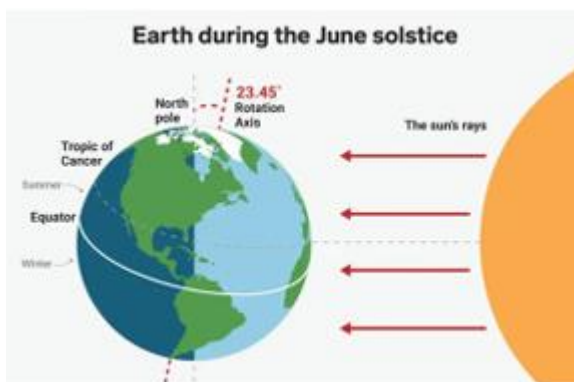
This week we will remember in prayer St Helier Methodist Centre, Rev Tony Morling
