- 2) Safeguarding Foundation Training**, there will be foundation training for some of the Pastoral visitors at SHMC on Thursday 25th September at 12:30pm, anyone else needing to do the training are welcome to join. Please contact Helen Higginson for more information (07797 725558).
- 3) Church works**, work is progressing well but due to a few complications the contractor is slightly behind by two and a half weeks, but the good news is that so far:
- The old rusty mesh has been removed and the iron bar on the soffit of the brickwork including the ends have been de-rusted and painted.
 - 52 Chemties have been installed - these are the special metal bars that are used to reinforce the masonry.
 - The cracks in the brickwork have been injected with special resin to provide extra reinforcement and waterproofing.
 - New stainless-steel mesh has been installed around the bottom of the brickwork.
 - The first and second coats of lime render have been applied to the brickwork.

The Contractors and the Property & Finance Committee thank the congregation for their patience whilst the work continues, there will be a three-week break in the work during August whilst the new lime render cures before the work can be completed.
