- 2) **Reggie Boisin**, we are asking for memories of Reggie Boisin who was a member of Aquila Road. He was a quiet man who helped to give out hymn books and take the collection. He lived locally, lately at David Moon House, Devonshire Place area. He has passed away at the age of 85. He had no family and few friends. If you are an old Aquila member and would like to join a small group in attendance, his funeral will be at the Crematorium (RJA&HS Trinity) on Wednesday 15th October at 11.30. Rev Dawn will take the service.
- 3) **Disciple Bible Study**, Rev Keith is excited to invite everyone to a new Bible Study called Disciple. He and Carolyn will co-lead the course on Thursday mornings at 11am. Rev Keith will also offer the course on Thursday evenings at 7 pm starting on September 18th in the youth lounge. Two 12 sessions explore both the Old and New Testament and includes daily readings, a video commentary from Biblical scholars and a focused exploration of passages each week offering participants a variety of interesting Bible study techniques. The course lasts approximately 1 hour. If you would like to join the course, please ask one of the Stewards on Sunday for this week's study guide.
