Chicken wire will be attached to the cross and we can insert flowers through the holes in the wire to symbolise the resurrection and new life.! We will fill the cross with flowers for all to see!**
- 2) Bible Study Group, there will not be any Bible study group or soup being served on Thursday 9th April, the group will be back on Thursday 16th April.**
- 3) Tax relief, the church is able to claim tax relief on any donations made to the church by Jersey taxpayers over a total amount of £50.00 in the year 2025. Tax refund forms are available in the vestibule for anyone wishing to participate in the scheme - complete the relevant details on the form and return to Martin Delap in the envelopes available with the forms.**

Adam Southall a young Jerseyman and now highly respected as a conductor in the UK and as an accompanist, will be conducting this work! The choir is now directed by William Millow- grandson of John Lobb who along with Stanley Sackett started the choir in 1956. Almost all of the choir's Spring performances were staged in SHMC, so there is a very special link between the choir and our church and, John Lobb was the organist here for many years.
